Professor Gary Wu received his MD degree from Northwestern University and completed his GI fellowship at the University of Michigan.

He has been a faculty member at the University of Pennsylvania for 21 years, where he is a Professor of Medicine and Associate Chief of Research for the GI Division. Professor Wu is the Associate Director of the NIH-funded Center for Molecular Studies of Digestive and Liver Diseases, where he is also the Director of the Molecular Biology/Gene Expression Core.

He has been elected to both the American Society for Clinical Investigation and the American Association of Physicians. Research in the Wu lab currently focuses on the impact of diet on the gut microbiome and its relationship to several aspects of host metabolism, including nitrogen balance, intestinal oxygen regulation, and epithelial intermediary metabolism.
