Professor Giovanni Barbara graduated Summa cum Laude in Medicine at the University of Bologna, Italy. He subsequently qualified in Internal Medicine and then in Gastroenterology at the same university. He was trained partly in London, UK, and completed a three-year post-doctoral research fellowship in neuro-immunology at McMaster University in Canada. Currently, he is involved in clinical gastroenterology, diagnostic and therapeutic endoscopy, teaching and research at the Department of Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology of the University of Bologna.

Professor Barbara's main research interest relates to basic and clinical aspects of functional gastrointestinal disorders and neurogastroenterology, and he has authored more than 150 indexed peer-reviewed articles and reviews on these topics, published in various biomedical journals, including *Gastroenterology*, *Gut*, *Journal of Clinical Investigation* and *Trends in Pharmacological Science*. He is, or has been, a member of the Editorial Board of *Gut*, *American Journal of Gastroenterology*, *Neurogastroenterology* and *Motility*, the *American Journal of Physiology* and other international scientific journals.

Professor Barbara has received numerous national and international awards, including the prestigious *Master Award in Gastroenterology* from the American Gastroenterological Association (AGA). He is currently President of the European Society of Neurogastroenterology and Motility (ESNM).
